



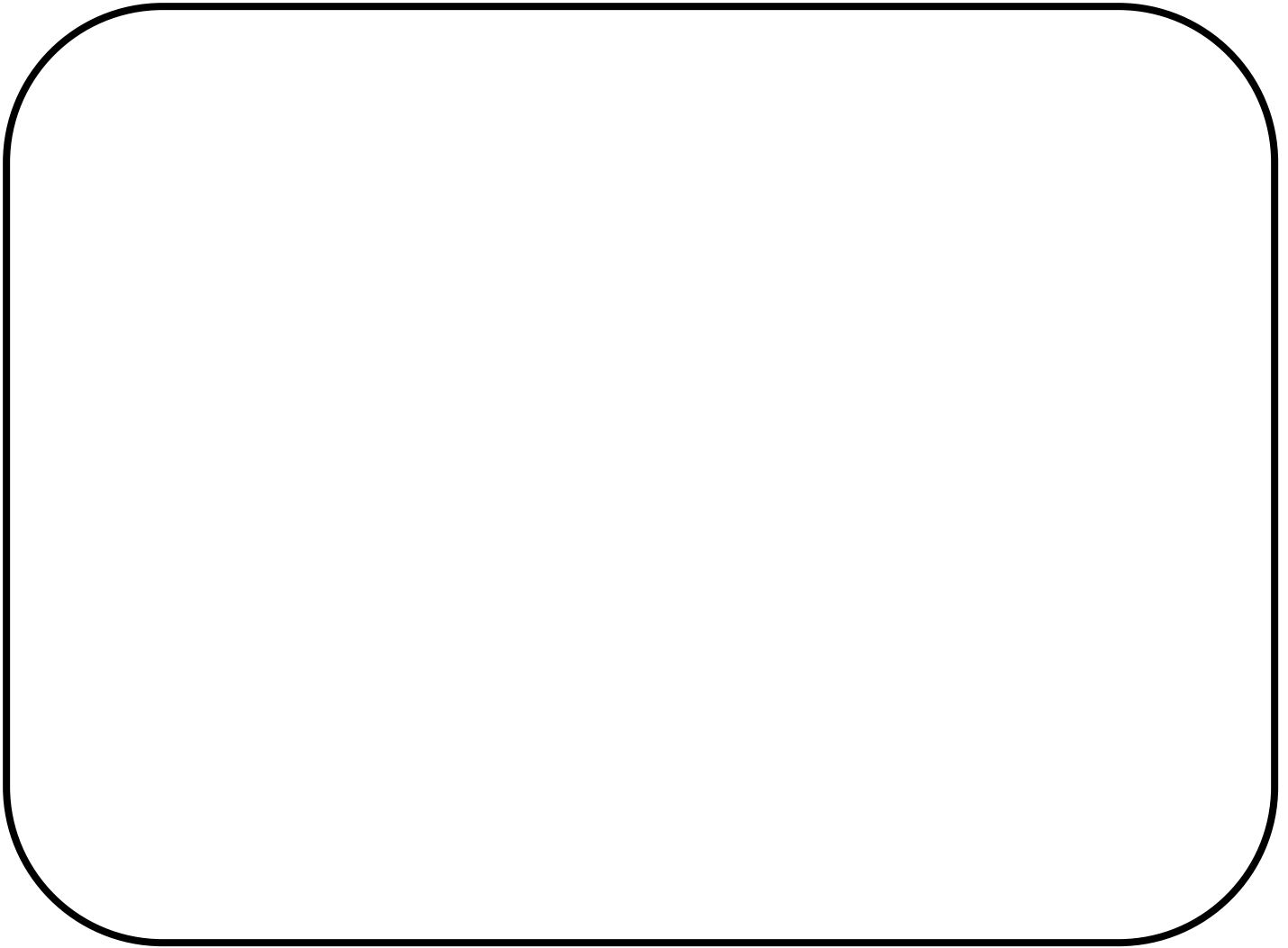
How can I see the wind?



This is what clouds look like to me.

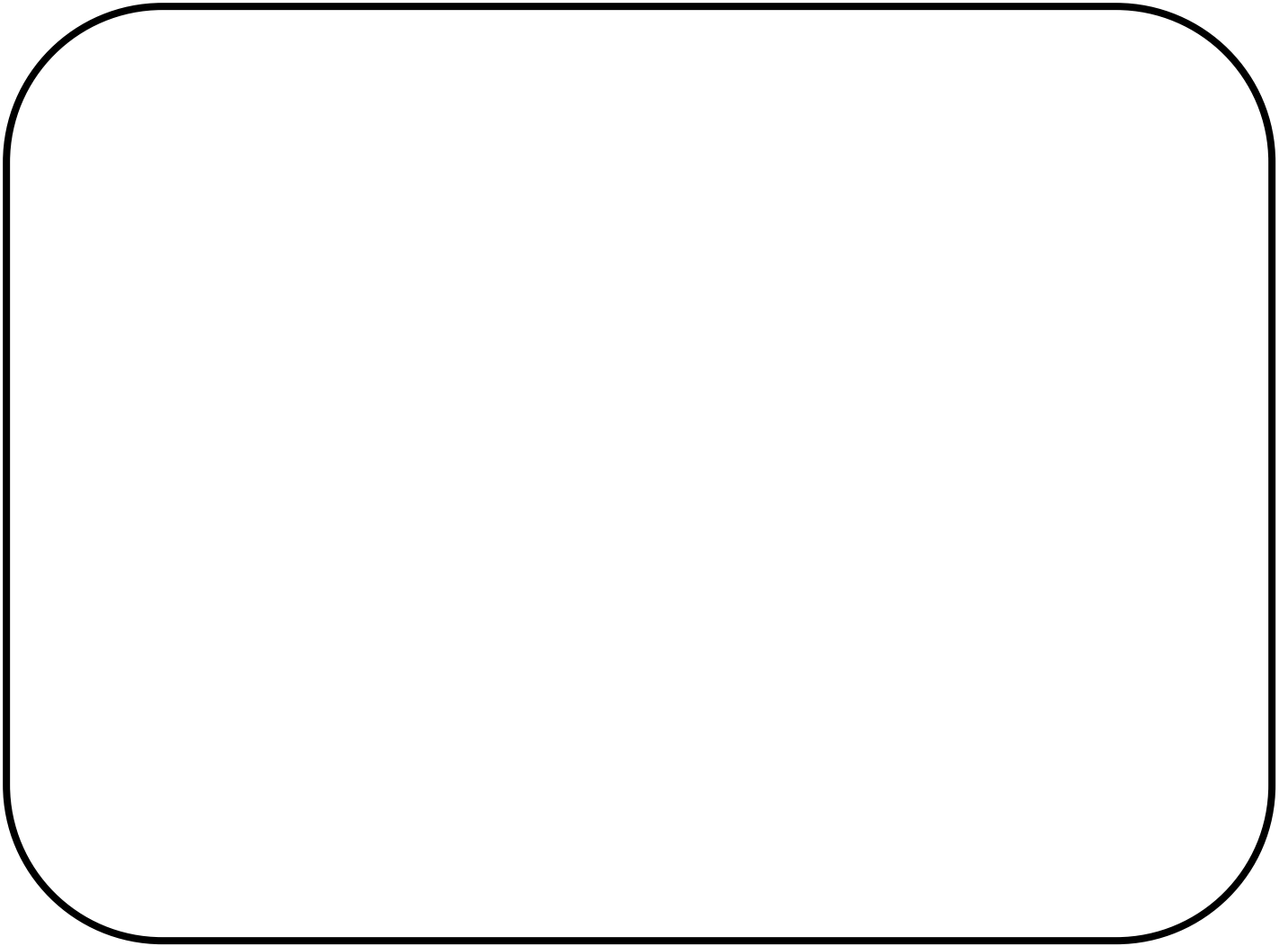
Rain
